Commissioner Morefield called the meeting to order at 11:03 a.m.

Campos gave a history of the Energy Ingenuity Fund and the reasons behind its development.

Garrett moved to adopt the remote meeting disclosure, which was read into the meeting record. Campos called role.

The meeting was opened to public comment; there was none.

Kilgore moved to approve the minutes from the last meeting on May 21, 2024; Jennings seconded; all members present voted "aye."

Silva gave a summary of the Pre-Applications from the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grant rounds.

The Energy Committee entered into closed session to discuss sensitive economic development projects. Kilgore moved to enter closed session; Garrett seconded; all members present voted "aye."
